2015 Sauvignon Blanc
Napa Valley

In recognition of the Latino farm working community, a special cause was conceived by Dave and his wife, Kim, nine years ago. Named to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe, a religious icon revered in much of Mexico, Veladora is a Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc historically sourced from the iconic Tofanelli Vineyard in Calistoga as well as select vineyards in Rutherford.

Winemaker's Notes

Pale straw with shades of gold, the wine offers complex tropical fruit notes with hints of key lime, grapefruit rind and lychee. With an energetic entry, flavors of kiwi, ripe cantaloupe, green apple, passion fruit and a touch of white pepper envelop the palate. Soon, this transitions into a pleasing, satiny texture complemented by a dash of vanilla and a lively beam of acidity. The wine has a long pithy finish supplanted with attractive minerality.

Cause
